SOLAR – Hyson Road Water Treatment Plant

In May 2014, the solar panels at the Hyson Road Water Treatment Plant were completed and the system became operational. The JTMUA is pleased to report that the system has been on-line for one year and has generated 620,671 kWh which is approximately 9% above our initial projection of 569,263 kWh. Based on JCP&L rates, this project has generated an annual savings of approximately \$50,000.00 and is producing 20% of our power needs.

The JTMUA will continue to benefit from this environmentally conscious cost savings on power for the next 14 years.

CELL TOWERS- Manhattan Street Monopole & Hyson Road Water Treatment Plant Monopoles

In August 2014, the Authority awarded Cellco Partnership, d/b/a Verizon Wireless, the co-location lease rights on the premises of the Manhattan Street Monopole and in November 2014, Verizon Wireless was awarded the co-location lease rights on the Hyson Road Water Treatment Plant Monopole. These lease agreements are in addition to the current agreements with T-Mobile on the New Mexico Water Tank, Sprint/Nextel, AT&T and T-Mobile on the two monopoles located at the Hyson Water Treatment Plant and T-Mobile located on the Manhattan Street Facility.

Both Projects should be completed by third quarter 2015.

These lease agreements not only provide better cellular coverage but also help stabilize rates by providing additional revenue.
