INTRODUCTION

The Jackson Township Municipal Utilities Authority (the Authority) was created by Jackson Township to provide water and sewer service to the residents of Jackson Township. While the Authority has broad statutory powers to provide these essential utility services, it has certain obligations as well. Its responsibilities include compliance with adopted Bond Resolutions, adopted service contracts with the Ocean County Utilities Authority and compliance with all applicable State and Federal Laws governing pollution control, drinking water quality, solid waste disposal, and other Municipal Laws and Ordinances.

The offices of the Jackson Township Municipal Utilities Authority are located at 135 Manhattan Street, Jackson, New Jersey. Its business hours are Monday through Friday, 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

Regular Public Meetings are generally held each month as advertised and in accordance with the provisions of the Open Public Meetings Act (N.J.S.A. 10:4-6 et seq.).
