- Subject to confirmation of legal compliance by the Authority's Labor Counsel, the Authority hereby ratifies the hiring of Robert Searles as a Laborer 1 (Meter Reader), on or about July 23, 2018, at an hourly rate of \$15.00, with benefits, pending final approval from the New Jersey Civil Service Commission.
- 2. The work duties of the position shall be as described in the New Jersey Civil Service Commission job description, attached as Schedule "A".
- Upon adoption of the within Resolution, the Executive Director, or his designee, shall forward copies to the Authority's Labor Counsel, the Transport Workers Union, the employee and to any other interested parties.
