WHEREAS, the Jackson Township Municipal Utilities Authority (hereinafter referred to as "Authority") is a duly-organized Municipal Utilities Authority under N.J.S.A. 40:14B-1 et seq.; and

WHEREAS, the Authority holds the exclusive right and franchise to provide sewer and water service to the lands within its district; and

WHEREAS, the Authority's legislative mandate is to acquire, construct, maintain, operate or improve works for the collection, treatment, purification or disposal of sewerage or other wastes and other statutory duties as delineated in N.J.S.A. 40:14B-1, et seq.; and

WHEREAS, the Authority believes that proper and careful planning is essential if it is to fulfill its vital role for the collection of sewerage and its disposal through the Ocean County Utility Authority's system; and

WHEREAS, the Sewer Master Plan adopted on June 25, 2009, via Resolution No. 2009-126, and amended on June 27, 2019 via Resolution No. 2019-087, serves as a flexible resource and guide for the Authority and others having an interest in ensuring an adequate, safe and cost-effective sanitary sewerage collection system within the Authority's service area; and

WHEREAS, Amendment No. 1 identified the Regional Pump to be located in Denton Pines Subdivision; and

WHEREAS, it is now desired that the location of the Regional Pump Station be located in the Swanborne Subdivision, which will allow the neighboring developments to flow by gravity into the pump station and eliminate contributory pump stations from certain developments; and

WHEREAS, the Authority's staff and the Engineering Committee are recommending that Amendment No. 2, as determined by the Authority Engineer's report as the most beneficial, cost-effective and operationally efficient for the Authority's sanitary sewer system and attached hereto as Schedule "A" be adopted and made part of the Sewer Master Plan.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Commissioners of the Jackson Township Municipal Utilities Authority as follows:

- 1. Subject to confirmation of legal compliance by the Authority's General Counsel, the Authority hereby adopts Amendment No. 2, attached hereto as Schedule "A", to the Sanitary Sewer System Master Plan dated October 2008 and amended on June 27, 2019.
