RESOLUTION NO. 2024-006

WHEREAS, the Jackson Township Municipal Utilities Authority (hereinafter referred to as "Authority") is a duly-organized Municipal Utilities Authority under N.J.S.A. 40:14B-1 et seq.; and

WHEREAS, the Authority holds the exclusive right and franchise to provide sewer and water service to the lands within its district; and

WHEREAS, Cardinale & Jackson Crossing #2 (hereinafter referred to as "Developer") is the owner of certain lands located in the Township of Jackson, County of Ocean known as Adventure Crossing Phase 3, Block 3001, Lot 1; and

WHEREAS, the Developer and/or Developer's assignee, is proposing to construct ten (10) mixed-use residential apartment buildings and commercial buildings containing a total of 481 residential units and 61,700 square-feet of commercial space. The project is located on the south side of Monmouth Road, adjacent to the Six Flags Great Adventure site. The Developer is applying for a Tentative Sewer and Water extension at this time. The Developer is proposing to construct an on-site sanitary sewer gravity system discharging to a pump station constructed under a separate phase of the project. The Developer proposes to provide water to the development by looping an eight-inch water main extension through the site, subject to the availability of sufficient water allocation, firm capacity, and elevated storage, and in compliance with the Authority's Rules and Regulations and the terms and conditions set forth in the Authority's Engineer's letter dated January 21, 2022, attached as Schedule "A"; and

WHEREAS, the Developer was granted tentative sewer and water approval via Resolution No. 2022-005 on January 27, 2022 and Tentative Compliance in the Authority's Engineer's letter dated January 19, 2024, attached as Schedule "B"; and

WHEREAS, tentative sewer and water approval is valid for a period of two (2) years in accordance with the Authority's Rules and Regulations; and

WHEREAS, the approvals expire on January 27, 2024 and the Developer has requested a two (2) year extension of time, attached as Schedule "C"; and

WHEREAS, the Authority's staff and the Engineering Committee are recommending a two (2) year extension to the tentative sewer and water approval be granted to Adventure Crossing Phase 3, Block 3001, Lot 1.

WHEREAS, the Jackson Township Municipal Utilities Authority (hereinafter referred to as "Authority") is a duly-organized Municipal Utilities Authority under N.J.S.A. 40:14B-1 et seq.; and

WHEREAS, the Authority holds the exclusive right and franchise to provide sewer and water service to the lands within its district; and

WHEREAS, PVS Minibulk, Inc. was awarded the 2024 Annual Furnishing of Chemicals, Sodium Hypochlorite, Bulk via Resolution No. 2023-185 on October 26, 2023; and

WHEREAS, PVS Minibulk, Inc. determined they were unable to provide Sodium Hypochlorite Bulk at the bid price and requested an increase from \$3.05 per gallon to \$3.62 per gallon; and

WHEREAS, PVS Minibulk, Inc. was awarded Task Order Change No. 1 relative to Contract No. CT-24003 to revise the price per gallon from \$3.05 to \$3.62, in the total amount of the contract from \$213,500.00 to \$253,400.00 on December 21, 2023; and

WHEREAS, on January 3, 2024, the Authority's Purchasing Department was informed PVS Minibulk, Inc. would be unable to deliver Sodium Hypochlorite to all the sites as indicated in the technical specifications of the bid; and

WHEREAS, the Authority will rebid the Furnishing of Chemicals, Sodium Hypochlorite, Bulk; and

WHEREAS, the Authority's staff and the Finance Committee are recommending the termination of the existing 2024 Bi-Annual Furnishing of Chemicals, Sodium Hypochlorite, Bulk, Contract No. CT-24003; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Commissioners of the Jackson Township Municipal Utilities Authority, County of Ocean, State of New Jersey, as follows:

- 1. Subject to confirmation of legal compliance by the Authority's General Counsel, the Authority hereby authorizes the Executive Director, or their designee, to execute the termination of contract with PVS Minibulk, Inc., relative to Contract CT-24003 as more fully described in the attached hereto Schedule "A".
