WHEREAS, the Jackson Township Municipal Utilities Authority (hereinafter referred to as "Authority") is a duly-organized Municipal Utilities Authority under N.J.S.A. 40:14B-1 et seq.; and

WHEREAS, the Authority holds the exclusive right and franchise to provide sewer and water service to the lands within its district; and

WHEREAS, GM Grawtown, LLC, (hereinafter referred to as "Developer") is the owner of certain lands located in the Township of Jackson, County of Ocean known as Pine View at Grawtown Road, Block 19403, Lot 4; and

WHEREAS, the Developer and/or Developer's assignee is proposing to construct forty-eight (48) single family residential units and 10 multi-family residential units within three (3) buildings on the north side of Grawtown Road, between East Veterans Highway and Whitesville Road. Preliminary water approval was granted on February 24, 2022 via Resolution No. 2022-036, which has since expired and in which the design has now changed. The Developer is applying for tentative sewer and water approval at this time. The Developer is proposing to construct a gravity sanitary sewer system conveying flow to a temporary pump station, which will ultimately convey flow to a permanent pump station to be constructed by others. The Developer also proposes to install a water main extension along Grawtown Road, extending through the subdivision and ultimately connecting to the water system to be constructed by the adjacent development, subject to the availability of sufficient water allocation, firm capacity and elevated storage, and in compliance with the Authority's Rules and Regulations and the terms and conditions set forth in the Authority's Engineer's letter dated October 18, 2023.

WHEREAS, the Authority has determined that there is no sewer capacity available to service the project at this time; and

WHEREAS, the Authority's staff and the Engineering Committee are recommending preliminary water approval be granted to Pine View at Grawtown Road, Block 19403, Lot 4.
