WHEREAS, the following WQM plan amendment is proposed and will be publicly noticed in the New Jersey Register:

- Name of Megan Commercial Office Building, Block 5601, Lots 61 and 74, prepared by Professional Design Services, LLC, attached as Schedule “A”;

WHEREAS, the Authority’s Engineer has recommended consenting to this WQM amendment, as it is consistent with prior Authority approvals, in a letter dated March 18, 2022, attached as Schedule “B”; and

WHEREAS, the Authority’s staff and the Engineering Committee are recommending consent to the proposed WQM plan amendment for a Megan Commercial Office Building, portion of Block 5601, Lots 61 and 74.



WHEREAS, the Jackson Township Municipal Utilities Authority (hereinafter referred to as “Authority”) is a duly-organized Municipal Utilities Authority under N.J.S.A. 40:14B-1 et seq.; and

WHEREAS, the Authority holds the exclusive right and franchise to provide sewer and water service to the lands within its district; and


