### **Title – Laborer 1**

**Position Responsibilities Include (It is important to note that the duties listed below are a brief description only and are not intended to cover the full range or scope of duties performed by Laborer 1):**

- Under direction, operates, adjusts, regulates, and maintains plant machines and equipment to purify and clarify water for human consumption and use.
- Conducts routine water testing of plant effluent for process control.
- Will gain knowledge of NJDEP water quality requirements to maintain compliance with regulations.
- Assists in maintenance and repair of equipment and appurtenances.
- Flush hydrants.
- Assist in the operation and maintenance of pumping stations.
- Respond to complaints regarding water quality, water leaks and pressure loss or no water and evaluate the situation.
- Timely and accurate completion of all required paperwork.
- Must be punctual, dependable, and meet all work scheduling requirements.
- Perform work safely and in compliance with OSHA regulations.
- Perform other related activities as assigned by supervisor or managers.

**Skills and Qualifications:**

- A valid driver's license is required.
- Pre-employment drug screen and background check.
- Ability to perform manual tasks either alone or as a member of a group.
- Ability to receive feedback and work well in a team environment.
- Ability to understand, remember, and follow oral and written directions.
- Ability to work harmoniously with associates, supervisors, and to deal effectively with the public.
- Ability to care for equipment, materials, and supplies used in operations work.
- Ability to follow safety precautions related to equipment and process chemicals.
- Basic computer skills are needed.
- Ability to utilize various types of electronic and/or manual recording and information systems used by the Authority.
- Ability to attend class and acquire the necessary Public Water Treatment Operator license issued by NJ Department of Environmental Protection.

**Physical Requirements:**

- Must occasionally lift 50lbs.
- Repetitive standing, walking, bending, twisting, stooping, climbing, reaching, and moving about on job site.
- Exposed to cold/heat/humidity. Position requires some work to be performed outside in all kinds of weather.
